

# How to Borrow Library eBooks for Your Kindle (Paperwhite, Keyboard & Older)

## What You Need

- A computer with Internet connection
- Kindle Touch and an Amazon Account

## Borrowing Kindle eBooks

1. On your computer, open your Internet browser and go to <http://downloads.live-brary.com>.
2. From this website, to find a Kindle eBook to read you can...
  - Click on a book cover
  - Click on a genre link to browse
  - Try a search by title or author
3. To sign in, click **Sign In** at the top of the screen or on the **Account** icon.
  - Select your home library and sign in with your library card number or username.
4. Most titles can be borrowed for 14 days. You can change this to 7 days by clicking on **(Change)**.
5. When you find an available *Kindle eBook* you want to read, click **Borrow**. Your eBook selection will be immediately checked out to you.
  - *Kindle devices can only download Kindle eBook formats.*
  - If an item is currently unavailable, you will see a **Place a Hold** button. Click this button and enter your email address. You will be notified by email when a copy is available.
6. Click **Go to Bookshelf**.
7. When looking at the book(s) checked out to you on your **Bookshelf**, click the **Download** button, check the box next to **Kindle Book**, and click **Confirm & Download**.
8. You will be redirected to Amazon.com, where you have to click the **Get for Kindle** button to get your library eBook.
  - If you're already signed into Amazon: From the drop-down box, select where you want the eBook delivered to. Then click **Continue** to deliver it to your device.
  - If you're not already signed in: click **Get library book** then sign in.
  - You will see acknowledgement that the eBook has been transferred to your device.

**Note:** *The Kindle, Paperwhite, and Keyboard allows for wireless eBook downloading over a WiFi connection. If you do not have an available Wi-Fi connection, you will need to transfer the title via USB. If you own an older Kindle with 3G, you will need to transfer the title via USB.*

9. After downloading your eBook through your computer, make sure your Kindle is connected to a wireless network.
10. Go to your Kindle's settings and tap the Sync command to make the eBook appear on your Kindle.
11. Once the eBook is on your device, you can open it from your Kindle home screen.
