

How to Borrow Library eBooks for Your NOOK Reader (Simple Touch and Older)

What You Need

- A computer with Internet connection
- A NOOK and its USB cable
- Adobe Digital Editions software installed on your computer

Browse, Checkout & Download

1. On your computer, open your Internet browser and go to <http://downloads.live-brary.com>.
2. From this website, find an **EPUB** eBook to read. You can...
 - Click on a book cover
 - Click on a genre link to browse
 - Try a search by title or author
3. To sign in, click **Sign In** at the top of the screen or on the **Account** icon.
 - Select your home library and sign in with your library card number or username.
4. Most titles can be borrowed for 14 days. You can change this to 7 days by clicking on **(Change)**.
5. When you find an available **EPUB** eBook you want to read, click **Borrow**. Your eBook selection will be immediately checked out to you.
 - *NOOK devices can only download EPUB eBook formats.*
 - If an item is currently unavailable, you will see a **Place a Hold** button. Click this button and enter your email address. You will be notified by email when a copy is available.
6. Click **Go to Bookshelf**.
7. When looking at the book(s) checked out to you on your **Bookshelf**, click the **Download** button, check the box next to **EPUB eBook**, and click **Confirm & Download**.
8. The title will open in Adobe Digital Editions. You can read the eBook on your computer and/or transfer it to your NOOK.

Transferring From Adobe Digital Editions to Your NOOK

1. Connect your NOOK to your computer using the USB cable. Your device will appear in the left column of Adobe Digital Editions.
2. With your mouse, select an eBook in your Adobe Digital Editions library and drag it to your NOOK. Hover over the NOOK icon, release and drop. Your eBook is now transferred onto your NOOK.

To locate transferred titles on your...

1st Edition NOOK: Go to **My Library** → Go to **My Documents**

NOOK Simple Touch: Go to your library. Make sure that **All** is selected in the box at the top-left.
